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AECOM provided preliminary design, final design and construction management services for the reconstruction of STH 32 (Franklin Street) from Grand Avenue through downtown Port Washington extending north to IH 43. This stretch of road is the main artery in Port Washington providing access to the marina, downtown, and interstate highway.

The project was designed using community-sensitive design guidelines and information gathered from the public, BID, and local officials. The design consisted of intersection operational analyses, typical section variations for traffic calming, streetscape opportunities, and new street lighting. Significant streetscaping will improve the business environment in downtown Port Washington and lead to economic development.

In addition, AECOM provided construction management, inspection, and contract administration for the different project elements, including: grading, base aggregate, concrete paving, asphalt paving, curb and gutter, sidewalk, lighting, underground utilities, signing, landscaping, and pavement marking.
